Hello, here at Camp Otter the days are filled with lots of fun and high activity play! Here are some important tips to remember:

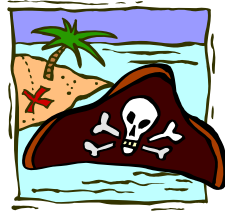
